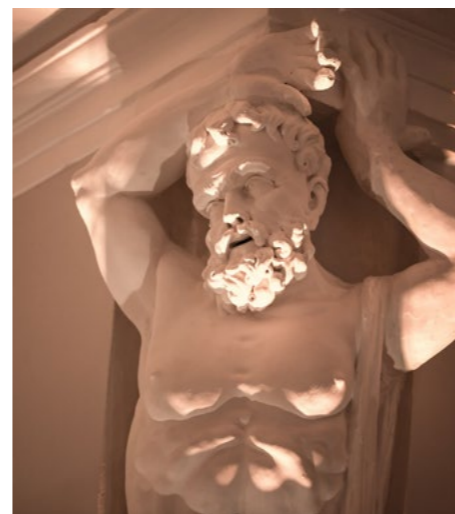

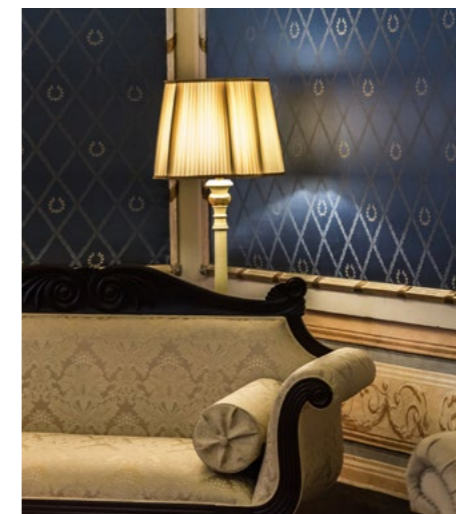

Our Story

The story of this magnificent building has its beginnings in Valletta in the early 1600s when it was occupied by various eminent and wealthy Italian gentry connected with the Knights of the Order.

Then known as Casa Pensa, its charm and legacy was not lost upon the populace. In 1805, the British Government transferred it to Dott. Giuseppe Nicolo Zamitt, who was knighted when the Order of St Michael and St George was instituted.

The building was re-christened Palazzo Zamittello in honour of its owner, a judge and notable figure. Such was his stature that, several years after his passing, his tombstone was eventually interred at St John's Co Cathedral in the chapel of the Langue de Auvergne; one of the very few

Maltese to be buried amongst the knights.

A monument was commissioned to honour him and, to this day, his statue stands in the Upper Barrakka Gardens. The house remained in the family, until this day and even now ownership can be traced back to Castello Zamittello, the family's country retreat in Mgarr, Malta.

The story of this exquisite 17th century home does not end here. Recently restored to its magnificent glory, it is now a fine hotel, where the traditional values expounded by its noble namesake are held true, and where all guests are treated with olde worlde courtesy.

BEDROOMS

Located in the Baroque city of Valletta the hotel has myriad unique merits, with rooms enjoying views of beautiful Republic Street, of the bustling open-air theatre or the serene inner courtyard.

The furniture has been carefully selected to be in keeping with the original design, finished in pastel shades with gold or silver filigree edgings for true authenticity. The bedding is especially noteworthy, as are the beds themselves, of which there is a choice of Emperor measuring 2 x 2.1 meters, the slighter smaller Super Kings or meter-sized single beds used in twin rooms.

Each room has a bathroom en suite, some equipped with a bathtub and others with a shower cubicle. Several also have bidets. The finest embroidered linen and towels are provided and a selection of different pillows are available.

Of course, our guests' comfort is paramount, and the hotel takes into consideration the famed Mediterranean climate. All bedrooms are equipped with air conditioning, as well as underfloor heating, while windows are double-glazed, to ensure that our guests' stay is as pleasurable whether during the balmy summers or the disarming winters.



All the modern conveniences are obviously included: facilities in the room include a direct dial telephone system, beverage making facilities, mini bar and a personal safe. The latest flat TV screen connected to cable, as well as satellite, is standard whilst a direct internet port hole is installed in each room, though Wi-Fi is also available in bedrooms and in all public areas of the hotel. Housekeeping services offered are complete and it is very unlikely that anything that guests may request cannot be provided.



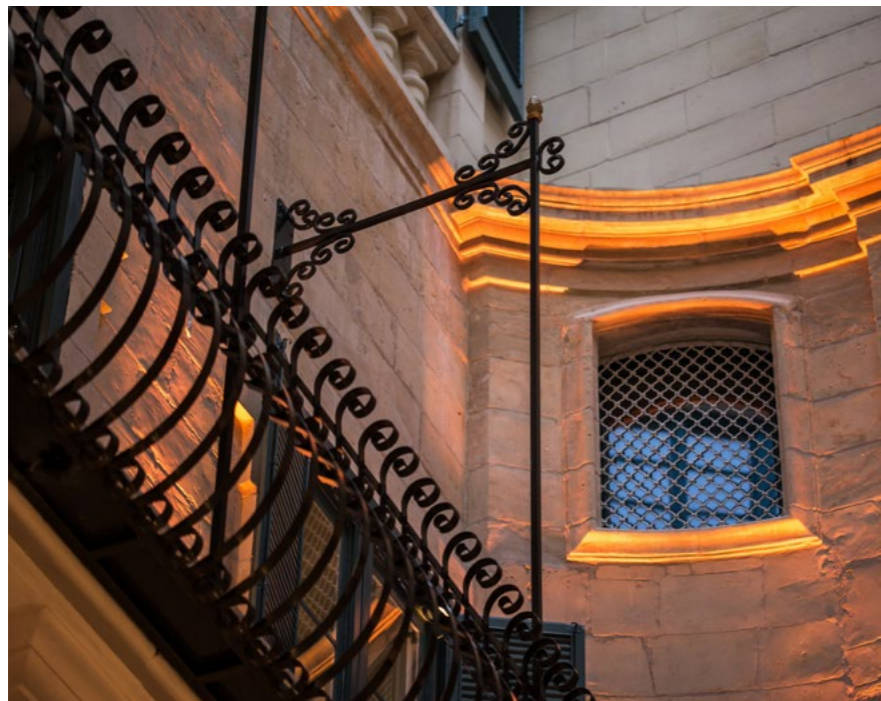

PUBLIC AREAS

THE COURTYARD

Located beside reception, this is also the access point to our Bar and Bistro. A throwback to a more classic architecture, the courtyard provides comfortable seating in an open area. Temperature control is provided by underfloor heating and air conditioning.

THE OPEN AIR TERRACE

To claim to have the most outstanding terrace in Valletta is no small boast. Overlooking Republic Street, the view extends all the way across the ruins of the old Opera House, as well as the new parliamentary building with a backdrop of the new City Gate and the Triton fountain in the near distance. It is the perfect place for residents to relax and enjoy the balmy weather while having drinks and snacks. It is also an ideal location for special events.

Meetings & Events

SALA DEL CONTE

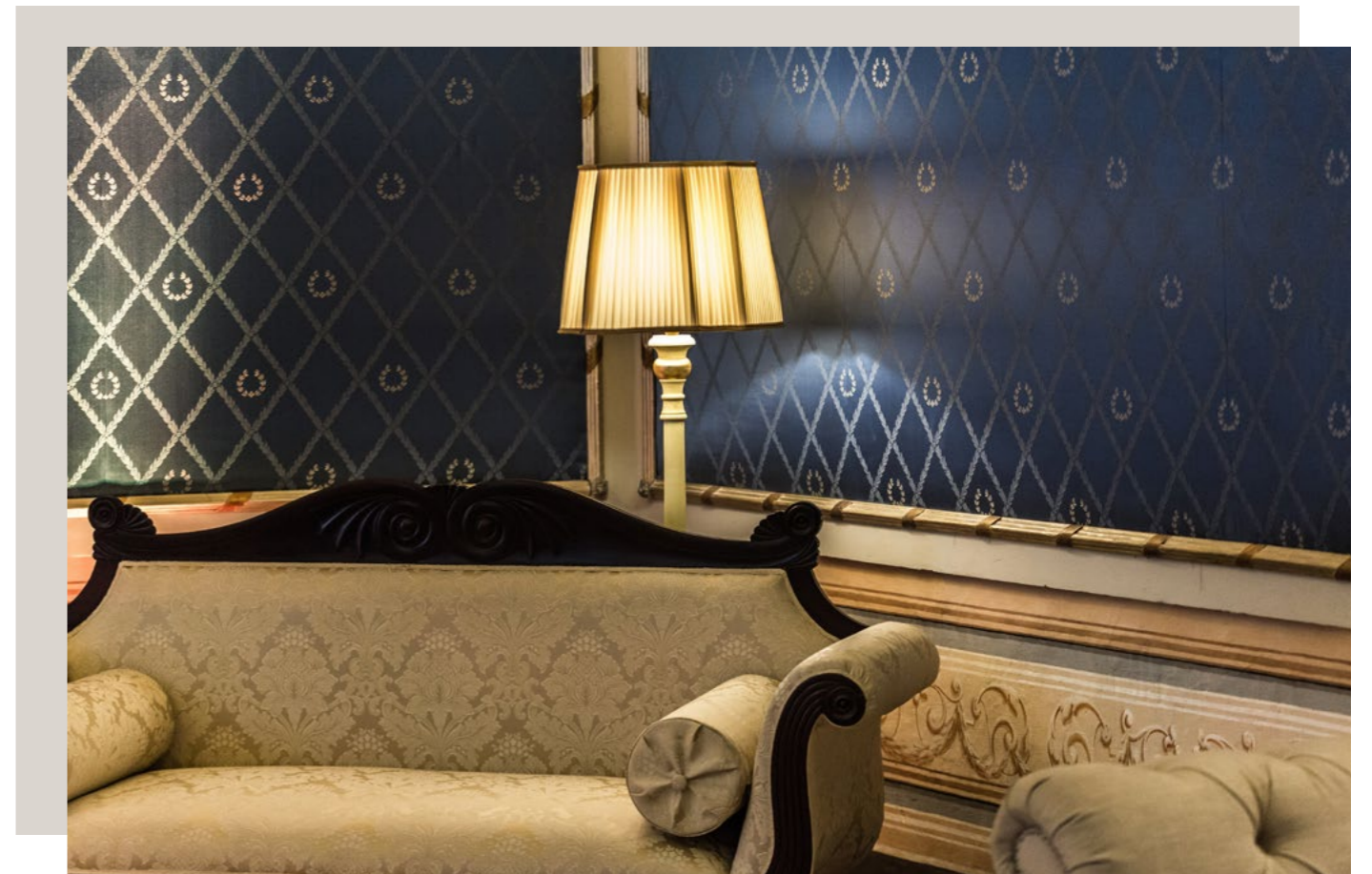
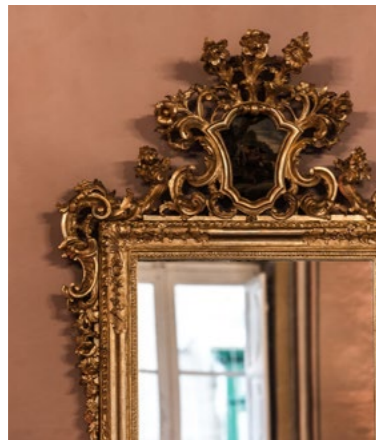

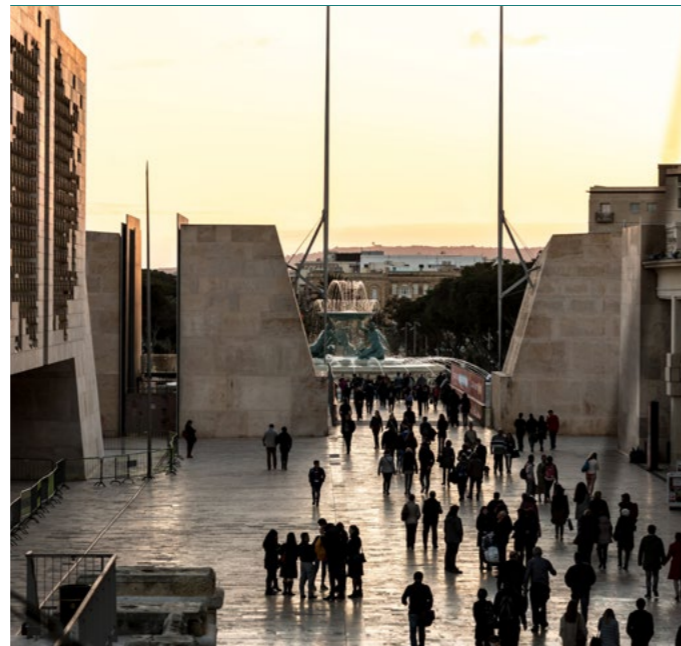
PRIVATE MEETING ROOMS
